'HAD IT NOT BEEN FOR DEBATE, I DO NOT THINK I WOULD BE WHERE I AM TODAY' GLENYZ PERREIRA TALKS DEBATE

Glenyz Pereira is a recent graduate of the University of Central Florida, where she earned a master's degree in communications, and she has been involved in speech & debate, both coaching and debating, since her time attending North Miami Beach Senior High School.

Pereira debated during MDUDL's earliest stages, and she continued speech & debate throughout her undergraduate studies at Miami-Dade College, where she earned a bachelor's degree in communications.

MDUDL welcomes you to read excerpts of Pereira's interview, conducted by Lauren Nieto, where she discusses the impact debate has made in her life.

MDUDL: How did debate change your life as both a student and a person?

Glenyz Perreira: Speech & debate taught me so many skills, including reading quickly and writing persuasively, and critical thinking. It encouraged me to spread knowledge, and if I taught one person something new and broadened their perspective, or planted the seed of change within someone, then I already felt like I had won.

MDUDL: How did speech & debate influence your post-high school studies and post-graduate school path?

Perreira: Speech & debate helped me realize that I love learning about how people communicate, and I later got introduced to the communications major during my undergrad. I specialized in intercultural communication and researched developing a way for speech & debate coaches to teach Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion in their coaching. Also, through coaching, I realized that I love teaching and want to pursue it.

MDUDL: What is a piece of advice that you want to share with current debaters?

Perreira: Don't be afraid to use your voice and advocate for what you care about. Also, be open to constructive feedback and know that your coach is able to help you with navigate certain situations. Most importantly, remember that every round, regardless of if you win or lose it, is a learning experience.
